General Functions:

In the framework of the activities of the IOM health programme (Cholera Response Project), under the direct supervision of the Health Cholera Team Leader and the overall supervision of the Health Program Manager, the incumbent will perform the following duties:

- Assist in conducting assessments to define health and communication needs of persons living in the communities affected with cholera, as well as health facility mapping in your designated commune.
- Assist in conducting rapid response activities for the cholera affected communities and coordinate activities with other partners.
- Facilitate trainings on a variety of cholera/ health topics to community health brigadiers/agents, community leaders and partner organizations in your designated commune(s).
- Monitor daily progress on the activities of community health brigadiers/agents, including collection of reports, monitoring of equipment, troubleshooting and ongoing support to community health brigadiers/agents.
- Attend daily briefing and provide written reports to your supervisor when necessary.

- Liaise with camp committees, partners and other actors working in the areas of responsibility to coordinate response activities
- Ensure documentation is collected for project activities and filed appropriately: including attendance records, and correspondence with local partners.
- Work together with health dispatch to ensure most vulnerable patients have access to transport and in most cases assisted them in the accessing of health services.
- Be available to work on weekends and public holidays in the case of an emergency and participate in regular on-call roster for weekends and public holidays.
- Perform any other duty as may be assigned.

- At least in 4 years experience in the health sector
- Flexibility and ability to work in difficult situations and in national/international settings as part of a team
- Ability to prepare clear and concise reports
- Creative and innovative thinking
